Comprising nine founding member organisations, the Wessex PIN is a regional group of staff and PPI contributors working within [NIHR](#) organisations across Wessex. The group aims to establish the area as a beacon of best practice in PPI, impacting positively on the reach, relevance and refinement of applied health research.
